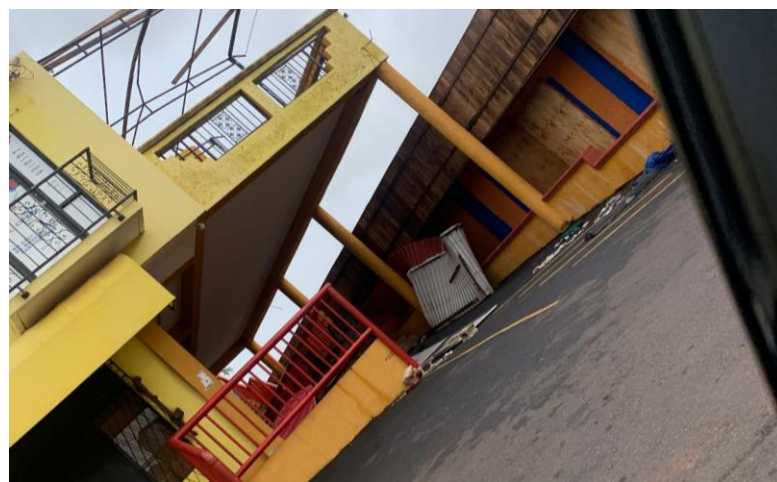

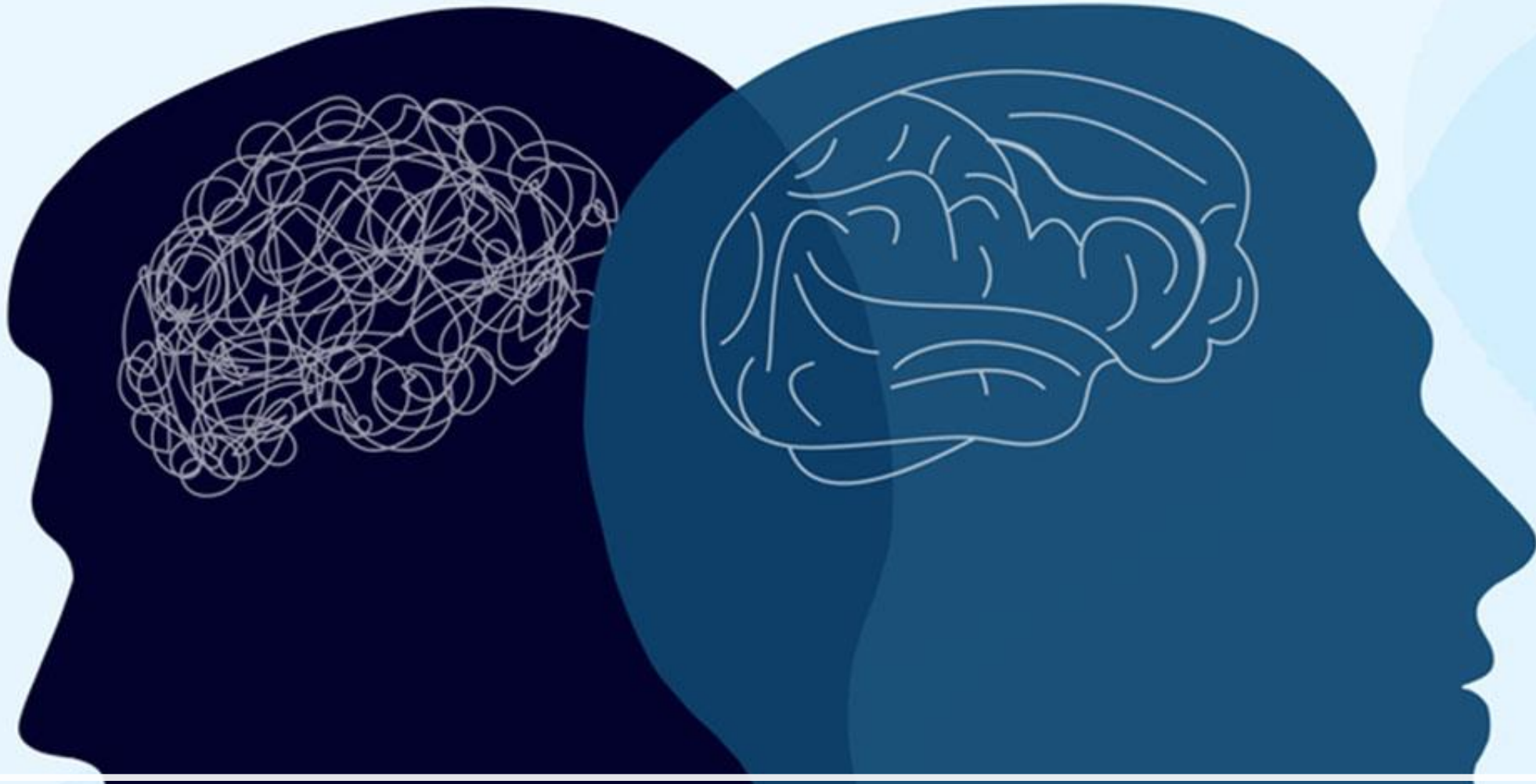



A hurricane is a violent warm-core tropical storm with a minimum wind speed of 119 km or (74 mph) rotating in a counter-clockwise spiral





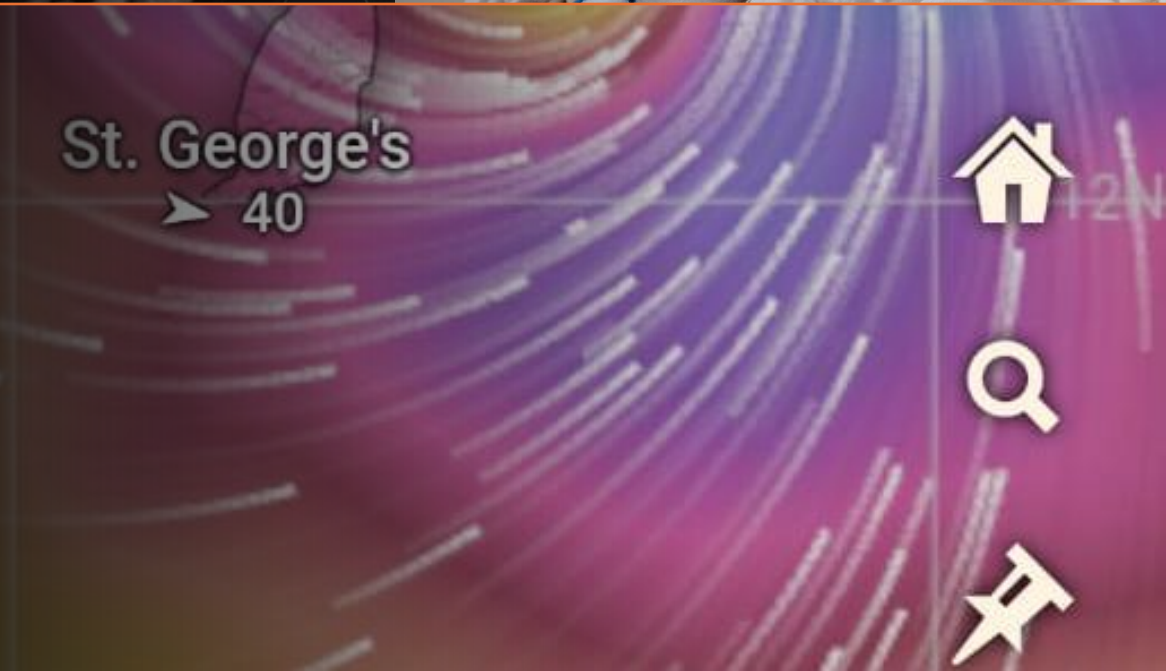
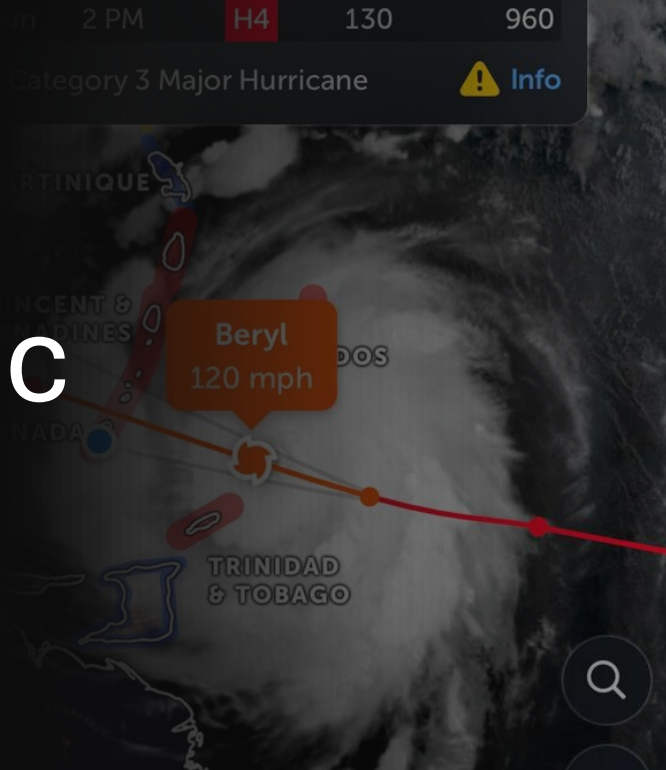


**THE DAY I BECAME A HURRICANE**

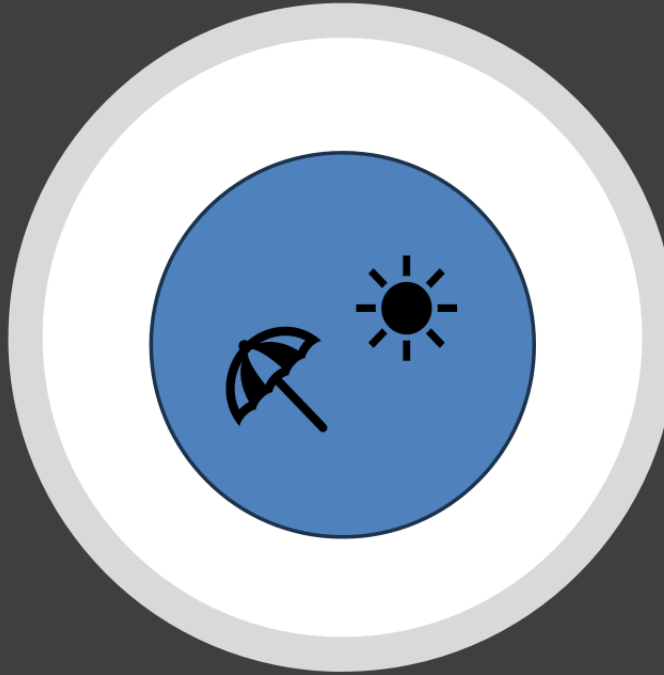
